A DAY & NIGHT IN COLORFUL GUANAJUATO



Guanajuato is one of Mexico's most beautiful and historically rich cities, known for its colorful colonial architecture, winding alleyways, and dramatic hillside views. Once a booming silver mining town, it played a key role in Mexico's fight for independence and still houses architectural gems like the Juárez Theater and the stunning Basilica of Our Lady of Guanajuato. The entire city is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and its preserved charm makes you feel as if you've stepped back in time.

The city is also culturally rich and was the birthplace of famed muralist Diego Rivera. We will tour the Diego Rivera House Museum, which showcases his early works and offers insight into his life and artistic journey.

Visiting Guanajuato is a feast for the senses—its cobblestone streets are lined with cafes, murals, and hidden plazas that beg to be explored. The city is also home to unique attractions like the famous Callejón del Beso (Alley of the Kiss). With its vibrant arts scene, charming cafes, and festive atmosphere, Guanajuato is a fun and inspiring place to visit.

MEET & SUPPORT MANO AMIGA WOMEN ENTREPRENEURS




